Contest Rules

1. <u>Topic:</u> The theme for the 2019-2020 Rotary Four-Way Middle School Speech Contest is "Rotary Connects the World" You may choose any topic related to this theme, provided that it is not profane, obscene, unpatriotic or racist. In the speech, the topic must be specifically subjected to the Rotary <u>FOUR-WAY TEST</u>. This must be during the body of the speech and is not to be reserved for concluding statements only.

The <u>FOUR-WAY TEST</u> of the things we think, say or do are:

First.... Is it the **TRUTH**?

Second....Is it **FAIR** to all concerned?

Third.....Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?

Fourth....Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?

- 2. Length: Speeches must be at least three minutes and no more than five minutes in length. Penalty points will be subtracted for time infractions at a rate of 2pts. Per 15 sec. over or under the proper length.
- 3. **Props:** No props are to be used. Audience participation is a prop.
- 4. <u>Speaker Aids:</u> Lecterns and microphones may be available for speakers to use if they so choose.
- 5. <u>Using Notes:</u> Contestants may speak from notes.
