The Air Over Our High Desert is a Busy Place

Craig Garrick, long-time Victorville Rotarian, represents ComAV, LLC; the parent company of Southern California Aviation (SCA) and Pacific Aviation Group (PAG), both located at the Southern California Logistics Airport. Craig occasionally takes time to update our Club on the many exciting things that are underway at this important airfield. Craig's company is responsible for the creation of jobs for our high desert residents, and is a huge player in the international arena of air transportation. Craig always has a fascinating program for us, and it is difficult to capture the momentum in a few paragraphs.

PAG: Pacific Aviation Group is an aviation asset management company providing asset evaluation, enhancement, marketing, sales and lease management services. They handle fleet management, aircraft deliveries, flight testing, aircraft and engine inspections, and more, including international marketing, sales, and lease management.

For over a decade SCA has been providing top-of-the-line service to customers around the globe. SCA combines expert aircraft maintenance technicians with quality customer service to provide the best experience possible during the various transitions of an aircraft's life.

Currently, there are 180 employees, with an average of five being added per month. The **average** annual salary is \$55,000, and the company is working aggressively to bring highly educated executives on board, with the goal
