## **SANBAG's Interstate I-15 and I-10 Corridor Projects**



Jane Derher, Public Information Officer from SANBAG (and Redlands Rotarian) was assisted by Edgar Gutierrez of Lee Andrews Group/SANBAG in a very informative presentation of

the "ins and outs" of the California freeway system. SANBAG is the council of governments and transportation planning agency for San Bernardino County, working in partnership with Caltrans and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The Power Point presentation showed just how busy they are.

Two particular "Corridor Projects" are of interest to us in the H.D.... Interstates 15 and 10. As stated in the information sheets, the purpose of these proposed projects is "to improve the movement of people and goods through the I-10 and I-15 Corridors". A campaign is currently being conducted throughout the county to inform the public about these projects. The population projection is growing



rapidly, and "Managed Lanes" will help eliminate traffic congestion. Two options are being considered: HOV (high occupancy vehicle) lanes or express lanes (two in each direction). The research takes time, so we won't expect much soon. We learned the ongoing work on the I-15 is to shore up the shoulders in preparation for the planned widening when funding is secured.
