Retired State Senator George Runner Shares His Insights as Legislator

George C. Runner, Jr. is the Republican Board Member for District 2 of the fivemember California State Board of Equalization. He has represented our area for many years, beginning with the Lancaster City Council in 1992, followed by five years in the State Assembly. He was a California State Senator serving from 2004 to 2012, prior to being elected to the Board of Equalization.

George is also a Rotarian, and presented to the Rotary Club of Victorville some of his insights gained from 12 years in the California Legislature. He brought bills related to sex crimes against children and found it difficult to get them passed. "Jessica's Law" was an initiative finally voted on as a result of the Legislature being unable to pass bills designed to protect children. George's biggest frustration was that legislators commonly agreed with his stance on important issues, but would rescind their support at the last moment due to pressure from members on their own side.

As stated on his web site, "As a Board member, my number one priority is to advocate for taxpayers. I believe that hard-working Californians deserve to have someone






working on their behalf in support of fair tax




