Common Core Standards Explained by Local Educators



A team of educators from area schools presented the facts on the Common Core Standards now being taught in schools from kindergarten through 12th grade. These standards are consistent academic guidelines in math and English language arts, created to help all students succeed. Our own Dr. Hough stated the focus is on analytical, critical thinking, and problem solving skills in all of the areas students will need to be proficient and be successful in their adult lives. Each panel member tackled a particular aspect of the topic, and spoke briefly. Merilee Moore of Brandman University spoke about teacher preparation for Common Core (CC); Victor Elementary School District's Kim Verduzco spoke on CC teacher development; Jennifer Spotts of Del Rey Elementary spoke on the CC Coaching available to schools; Lori Clark spoke about the financial requirements for CC, and lastly, Bill Flynn from Excelsior talked about parent support.

Otha Thornton, President of the National PTA says the following about Common Core: "As a parent, businessman, and the leader of the nation's largest child advocacy association, I believe the standards are an essential tool to ensure every child receives a high-quality education that prepares him or her for success upon graduation from high school".








MEMBERSHIP REWARDS




