MAKING SENSE OF THE NUMBERS IN RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE

Caroll Yule, Owner of Shear Realty, updated the Rotary Club of Victorville on the state of residential real estate in the High Desert. Caroll's presentation was very easy to understand, given the complexity of the market over the past several years. She showed how each of the years since 2006 have seen a unique twist in the housing market. To explain where we are today, we can compare:

* 3,304 homes listed on MLS

★ 505 homes closed

* 22 homes closed (Caroll was suicidal)

May '09: * Height of the foreclosure market

* 32,170 homes listed on MLS

* 90 - 95% of listings were bank owned * 692 homes closed averaging \$53,000

* Market bottomed out

> * 49% bank owned * 464 homes closed

* 17% bank owned

Caroll went on to explain the ramifications of these numbers, and she is optimistic that soon the real estate market will improve. Hooray! In our market right now, the demand is huge, and the supply is little. Well priced homes in a good area in the H.D. (under \$200,000) receive 10-15 offers, and there is only a 4-week inventory!
