A HISTORY OF THE CHP BY COMMANDER TODD STURGES

The primary mission of the California Highway Patrol is "the management and regulation of traffic to achieve safe, lawful, and efficient use of the highway transportation system." Our own Rotarian, Todd Sturges, enlightened us on some historical "factoids" about the beginnings of the CHP, and shared some of the highlights of it's continued growth.

Todd introduced Barbara Stumbaugh, a Senior CHP Volunteer, whose late husband, Gene, was an officer since 1958. Barbara has been involved with the CHP for a long time, and is a fountain of knowledge.

Todd shared that there were few traffic laws in 1929 due to the amount of vehicles on the roadways, and when the traffic officer squad formed that year, the patrolmen supplied their own vehicles and uniforms, and were a branch of the DMV. There were two Barstow patrolmen, responsible for an area of 10,000 square miles, and each earned approximately \$400/mo.

Back in "the day", Highway Patrolmen carried a 38 Revolver, a pair of handcuffs, and re-loads. They worked six days a week and were on call 24/7. Todd told about several notable officers, however, to the Rotarians of the Victorville Club, the late Bill O'Keeffe, was "Mr. California Highway Patrol". Bill retired from the CHP in 1981 and was "Rotarian of the Year" for the Rotary Club of Victorville in 1972. Thank you, Todd, for the informative history lesson on the CHP.


