Senator Steve Knight updates Rotary on important issues

Senator Knight reviewed some of the most crucial items facing California's future following a slow recovery after a five to six year recession. In a nutshell...

State Budget: The Budget finally passed with some tweaking and the state is holding back some money for a rainy day.

Pensions: Need to be addressed in the very near future.

Prisons: Need more beds or allow more prisoners to leave the system. We have more population in California, thus more crime; private prisons may be the answer.

Public Education: STAR Testing will be obsolete as we know it; going to core standards. Our children will need to compete with kids from other countries getting into American colleges, so better testing is required.

Transportation/Highway System: Interesting discussion about the increase of hybrid and electric vehicles on the roads. The 36-cent gas tax going into the state treasury will disappear, but highways still need to be maintained.

Senator Tim Donnelly will be running for Governor in the next election, and Senator Knight wishes him luck; it will be tough to beat Governor Brown.

Congratulations to Senator Knight for his appointment to the Governor's Military Council of 19 members. They will be addressing two items of concern to California: (1) BRAC (Base Realignment and Closure) in 2015 (protecting the military bases left in California), and (2) how Sequestration will impact our state.

His job is about stopping bad bills from being passed, and pushing forward the good bills. Steve will vote about 3,000 times in two years, and reads the description of each bill religiously. We thank Senator Knight for taking time from his busy schedule to visit Rotary!
