SANBAG V.P. Updates Rotary Club on SoCal's Highway Plans

Ray Wolfe, Executive Director of SANBAG, was introduced by Ryan McEachron, SANBAG Board member, to update us about key ongoing and upcoming projects. San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG) is the council of governments and transportation planning agency for San Bernardino County.

Two exciting projects that directly affect our high desert are the La Mesa/Nisqualli Interchange and the Ranchero Road Interchange, both of which will alleviate Bear Valley Road gridlock. The ceremony to open the La Mesa/Nisqualli Interchange will be this Friday at 1:30 p.m. for those interested in attending.

By the end of this year, the Yucca Loma Bridge should begin construction, as well as the Green Tree Road improvements.

Cal Trans and SANBAG are also working on U.S. 395 improvements, which will be underway within a couple of years.

The "High Desert Corridor" is another planned project which has had setbacks over the past several years. This is a multi-billion dollar project, and a multi-use project, including transmission, generation, and rail corridors, all packaged together, which Ray says should help to secure some federal money. This route would link State Route #14 to State Route #15, and would be a partial toll facility. Notably, SANBAG has partnered with Congressman Paul Cook's office to assisting returning veterans by working with business to provide opportunities to our veterans transitioning from active duty to civilian life, in recognition of their service.
