Southern California Logistics Airport Fire/Rescue



Victorville Rotarian Dan Munsey invited the Rotary Club of Victorville to tour the fire station located at Southern California Logistics Airport, formerly George Air Force Base. A delicious luncheon of tri-tip and trimmings was barbecued by crew members and two of their wives. It was an honor to have special guest Garner Morris, who was stationed at this base with 18 others from 1963 through 1984! Also, our own Dick Cole served as de-commissioning Base Commander of George Air Force Base prior to its closure in 1992!

The San Bernardino County Fire Department, Victorville Division, staffs the Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting (ARFF) program for the City of Victorville at the Southern California Logistics Airport (SCLA). Station #319 responds to approximately 100 calls per year, and subject to FAA standards, response time within the airport is one minute. Firefighter Brent Cannon introduced us to the various apparatus housed (see photo of John Hulterstrom on "Striker"). In addition to three water trucks and two foam trucks (ranging from 1,000 to 4,000 gallons), the unit operates rescue, training, and fire fighting equipment. Flight Firefighter Paramedic Eric Sherwin and Sheriff Deputy "Q" Quezada fascinated us with visuals of how hoist rescues are made using the helicopter "Air Rescue 6". The "Striker", an impressive water truck, is equipped with a 50' boom stick with a "piercing nozzle" as well as infrared cameras which show fires inside a plane's fuselage. Obviously, the tour of the fire station was fascinating! We thank the crew from the Aircraft Rescue Fire fighting unit: Captains Dave Weaten, Dave Wetzel, and Pete Lawson (chef with wife Shannon), Engineer Mike Bell with wife Tina, Firefighter Brent Cannon, Flight Captain Paramedic Kyle Haudaceur, Flight Firefighter Paramedic Eric Sherwin, Sheriff Pilot Deputy Landry, Sheriff Deputy Quezada, and Staff Analyst Nicole Smith.
