HOW LACK OF SLEEP AFFECTS EVERYTHING WE DO



Sleep Apnea is one of many sleep disorders which plaque Americans and interrupt their everyday lives. Dr. Ravidra Chandrashekhar, Internist from St. Mary's Medical Center, also specializes in sleep medicine, and brought an interesting program to the Rotary Club of Victorville this week. Dr. "Robbie" had a PowerPoint presentation depicting the many reasons "good sleep" is important, and how sleep issues affect our health.

Sleep problems, including snoring, sleep apnea, insomnia, sleep deprivation, and a myriad of other sleep "issues" are common. In sleep apnea, the airway can collapse and block air flow to the lungs. As a result, the quality of sleep is poor, affects our overall well being, and can contribute to additional medical problems, such as chronic tiredness and depression,

and even diabetes and insulin resistance.

Good sleep is necessary for optimal health and can affect hormone levels, mood and weight. Many conditions that cause death in the U.S. (Oct. 2012 Vital Statistics Reports) are directly or indirectly affected by our airway and quality of sleep. If you have disturbed sleep and are unaware of it, getting enough sleep is not enough due to the poor quality of sleep you are receiving. Some factors that help improve the quality of sleep are keeping the room dark with as little noise as possible. He recommends good sleep hygiene (going to bed and arising at the same time each day); no bad habits (use the bed for only the two things it is intended for); and don't eat three hours prior to sleeping. Dr. Robbie suggests you see your family doctor if you feel your are suffering from any type of sleep disorder, as it relates to your health.
