Teacher Mini Grants

This week we held our Annual Teacher Mini-Grant Program and it was one of our biggest yet! Out of 91 applications submitted, 41 teachers received Grants, totaling \$12,113.00! This year's Grant reviewers were **Dwight Johnson**, **David North** and **Caroll Yule**. Rotarian **Alicia Anderson** emceed the program and was assisted by **Ryan McEachron** who handed out certificates to the deserving educators.

Teachers from Excelsior, the Helendale School District, Oro Grande School District, Victor Elementary School District and the Victor Valley Union High School District received Grants for such programs as "Teacher, I Blew Up the Classroom" which connects microscopes to laptops for science studies and digital innovation, "Dream Graphics" which allows younger students to create clip art and projects using tablets and digital pens, "Bluegrass in the Schools", where over 100 instruments are used to teach students about America as well as music, "Science Camp" which takes low income students to Big Bear for 4 days of outdoor science lessons, and "Speak It-Write It-Print It", which teaches History and Journalism through the use of a working printing press!

Thank you to everyone involved with this year's program, from volunteers to donation sponsors, who made the event so special. Most importantly, thank you to the dedicated and creative teachers, that make learning not only fun, but effective!
